

# **HOSSEGOR SAUVETAGE COTIER**









The Festival Oceanman International is organised by Hossegor Sauvetage Côtier. It will take place in Hossegor central beach on the **28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of April 2012**. This year, some events have changed to offer a greatest show for spectators.

## IMPORTANT NOTES. NEWS IN 2012 !

Oceanman/oceanwoman : the order will be surfski/swim/board

Board relay : this a relay with 3 lifesavers with

**Taplin mixte relay (6 lifesavers) :** 6 lifesavers will compose the relay with 3 women and 3 men. Each leg will be race twice (2xski, 2xswim, 2xboard) and have to be race by a woman and by a man. You have the choice of the order between the woman and the man. Taplin relay order is the same than those of the oceanman/oceanwoman.

If you don't have a full team (3 men/3girls), you can join other teams to make the relay.

Entries fees are independent from general entries fees. Each team needs to pay 30 euros to race (5 euros per competitor). All the entries fees of the taplin mixte will constitute the prize money of the event. The first 3 teams will be recompensed. And each team will receive a surprise gift. Registration for Taplin Mixte will be held on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> until Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> before the race. But you can register your team before. The Taplin mixte challenge doesn't count for the general ranking neither for teams ranking.

## COMPETITORS AND TEAMS

The Festival Oceanman International is open to all I.L.S. members and F.F.S.S. members, from the category 1997 to Open.

### **INDIVIDUAL EVENTS**

All events will be raced in a single age category "open". All under 18 competitors <u>up to 14 years old</u> should provide an authorization of their team manager and they should come with an adult.

#### TEAM EVENTS

In a team, the number of competitors is not limited. However, a team cannot present more than 3 relays par event. The team could represent a city, a region, a nation, a selection between competitors from different clubs or countries. It should have a precise name and a responsible captain. A team can engage different relays on several events. A male/female relay will compete in an event with the male relays.

#### REGISTRATION

Each competitor must pay a 15 euros fees to race the event. Entry fees and engagement forms should be returned to Hossegor Sauvetage Côtier before the 20<sup>th</sup> of April 2012. Late entry fees will be raised by a 10 euros penalty.

#### EQUIPMENT

Competitors will make sure they have the necessary equipment before entering the event. Each club will organize the equipment rotation among its teams to avoid disturbing the competition. Equipment problems shouldn't late the race. Equipment must meet the standards approved by I.L.S. Competitors shall wear identical team swim caps. These swim caps securely fastened under the chin must be worn at the start of each event. The team lycra tops are recommended but not compulsory during the event.

14 & 15 years old competitors have to race on a nipper.

#### CLASSIFICATION

There will be a classification and a podium for each individual and relay event. By the end of the competition, the overall scored points will determine the females, males, female teams, male teams and teams that have been the most regular during the competition.

<u>General classification individual females and males</u>: It will be established by adding the points earned by each lifesaver during individual events to determine the best female and male lifesavers.

<u>General classification female and male relays</u>: It will be established by adding the points earned by each team during relays events to determine the best female and male teams.

<u>General classification interclubs</u> : It will be established by adding the points earned by each lifesaver during individual and relays events to determine the best teams.

## **DIVERSE**

- For individual events, only the points earned by the three first lifesavers will count for interclub classification. Past the three first ones, the other members of the team are blocking the points.
- For relay events, 3 relays can be raced per team but only the points of the first one will count for interclub classification.
- > Ties in overall point scores shall be broken using the following system : most first-place final finishes, most second-place final finishes,...

## PRIZE MONEY

The total prize money of 1400 euros will award the best lifesavers and the best teams of that competition. The share will be done as indicated below (price in euro):

## **OFFICIALS / RACE COMMITTEE**

Each club shall delegate at least one accredited lifesaver to the race committee which will meet on the evening prior to the event. Referees and judges are required to attend the appropriate briefings to review judging sheets and event procedures.
